The Centre's strategy is as follows:

- Year 1 2020: 20 books in 200 homes, plus gathering baseline information
- Year 2 2021: Research the impact and continue supplying current families that have young children - select 10% sample and get them to 80 books over next two to three years
- Year 3 2022: Start the same process with a new set of 200 families, utilising the research findings to improve the programme.
